Eligibility Requirements

Prerequisites:

- **Must be credentialed as an ARRT Registered Radiologic Technologist or NMTCB Registered Nuclear Medicine Technologist**
- Unregistered applicants who have recently graduated from an accredited radiologic technology program may be granted conditional acceptance pending registry completion. **Registry must be obtained prior to the start of CT courses.**

- 1. Complete the online application and submit the \$15 application fee for the Computed Tomography Certificate Program via bshp.edu.

- 2. Submit a copy of your ARRT or NMTCB credentials to advising@bshp.edu.
- 3. Submit a copy of your High School Diploma, High School Transcript, or GED Certificate. If applicable, submit DD214 and Military Transcripts (per Department of Education and VA Regulations).
- 4. Email your Admissions Advisor (advising@bshp.edu) to verify your application has been properly submitted.

After you are accepted, be prepared to provide:

- CPR Certification (Basic Life Support from the American Heart Association)
- GroupOne Background Check Clearance
- Driver's License
- Proof of Health Insurance
- Social Security Card
- Health Screening

Health Screening*:

Health screening will be done with our student health nurse after you are accepted to the program. To complete the health screening, incoming students are required to show proof of the following vaccinations:

Hepatitis B	Influenza (Flu)	COVID-19	Varicella
